## 10th Annual Cello Camp

BLOOMINGTON, Ill.— Illinois Wesleyan University will host its tenth annual Cello Camp June 10-20.

The program, which enrolls 30 participants from more than 10 states, includes daily private lessons, cello ensembles, master classes, elective classes and concert performances as well.
