Carney-Hall to Lead Student Affairs



BLOOMINGTON, III.— Karla Carney-Hall, vice president for student affairs at Hendrix College, has been named vice president for student affairs and dean of students at Illinois Wesleyan University. She succeeds Kathryn Cavins-Tull, who left Wesleyan in July to become vice chancellor for student affairs at Texas Christian University.

President Richard F. Wilson announced the appointment of Carney-Hall following a national search that began over the summer.

"Dr. Carney-Hall is uniquely qualified to become our next vice president for student affairs and dean of students," said Wilson. "She impressed the campus community with her broad range of experience at two excellent residential liberal arts colleges and with her passion for creating environments that foster student success."

At Hendrix College, Carney-Hall provided leadership for all areas of student life, residential life, Karla Carney-Hall advising, health and wellness, career services and intercollegiate athletics. She was a member of the president's cabinet and was actively engaged in the College's strategic planning. Among her many accomplishments were overseeing the planning and building of two new student apartment style residences and a \$26.5 million student life and technology center.



Dr. Carney-Hall also spent eight years at Cornell College in Mount Vernon, Iowa as dean of students and associate dean of students. In addition, she has held various student affairs positions at the University of North Carolina at Wilmington and Miami University in Oxford, Ohio. A Louisiana native, she earned a Ph.D. in student affairs administration and research from the University of Iowa, holds a master's degree in higher education administration from Florida State University and a bachelor's degree from Louisiana State University.

Dr. Carney-Hall is married to Eric Hall, a native of Iowa. The Halls have an infant son, Brendan.
