# IWU Homecoming to Feature World Premiere of DreamWorks Film Puss in Boots, Opening of Time Capsule, Kaotic Drumline

BLOOMINGTON, III. - It will be a year to honor those who work behind the scenes and take the stage at Illinois Wesleyan University's *2011 Homecoming: Lights, Camera, Action* from Oct. 21-23. Events below are free and open to the public.

The new DreamWorks Animation movie *Puss in Boots* will have a world premiere at Illinois Wesleyan University before it hits movie theaters, thanks to alumnus Bill Damaschke '85, chief creative officer of the animation company responsible for the enormously successful *Shrek* and *Kung Fu Panda* films. Damaschke, who will also be honored at this year's Homecoming as the **distinguished alumnus**, will host a screening of the movie at 8:30 p.m. Friday, Oct. 21, at Hansen Student Center (300 E.
