IWU Student Awarded Art Scholarship

BLOOMINGTON, III. – Illinois Wesleyan sophomore art major Leeya Jackson recently received the Studio Arts Center International (SACI) Consortium scholarship. Worth \$11,800, the award will allow Jackson to study abroad at SACI in Florence, Italy for the Fall 2011 semester.

SACI is a U.S. not-for-profit university art and design program. The organization has awarded \$79,000 in scholarships to students studying at SACI in the upcoming semester.
