Dr. Carole D. Paul, associate professor of French and Spanish at IWU, joined the Foreign Language faculty in 1976. Paul received her bachelor of arts degree in Spanish, magna cum laude, from the University of Illinois. Her master of arts degree in French, as well as her doctorate degree in French, are also from the U of I. She has done additional studies at the Université de Rouen in Rouen, France, and at the Bibliothèque Nationale in Paris, France.

Dr. Paul is a member of Phi Beta Kappa and Phi Kappa Phi, national scholastic honorary societies, and received the Pi Delta Phi prize for Excellence in French in 1968. She was also an NDEA fellow from 1968-1971.

Dr. Paul has had numerous articles published, including literary criticism of the 17th Century French novel, as well as articles concerning foreign language methodology. Her research in these areas is also the subject of papers she has delivered at language conferences and workshops.

Currently under consideration for publication is *Spanish for Careers in Medicine*, a first-year Spanish text with specific vocabulary, conversation drills and diagrams. The text reflects Dr. Paul's interest in different approaches to teaching the basic foreign language sequence.
