Civic Orchestra to Perform at Center for the Performing Arts

BLOOMINGTON, Ill. – The Illinois Wesleyan University Civic Orchestra is scheduled to perform a concert Friday, Nov. 10, at 7:30 p.m. at the Bloomington Center for the Performing Arts, 107 E. Chestnut St., in Bloomington.

Admission for the concert is \$10 for adults, \$5 for senior citizens and IWU alums, \$1 for Illinois Wesleyan, Illinois State, and high school students with a valid ID, and free for students eighth grade and younger.

Steven W. Eggleston, Civic Orchestra founder and IWU professor of music, will conduct the ensemble in their performance of *Symphony No. 5* by Shostakovich, *Holberg Suite* by Grieg, and *Academic Festival Overture* by Brahms.

Now in their 22nd season, the Civic Orchestra is an ensemble comprised of IWU students and Bloomington-Normal area musicians.
