BLOOMINGTON, Ill. – The Illinois Wesleyan Jazz Lab Band will present a concert on Friday, Nov. 6 at 7:30 p.m. The concert will be held in Westbrook Auditorium of Presser Hall (1210 Park St., Bloomington) and is free and open to the public.

Tom Streeter, professor of music and director of the jazz program at Illinois Wesleyan, will direct the performance.
