BLOOMINGTON, Ill.- In celebration of National Women's History Month, Illinois Wesleyan's student-run Feminist Majority Leadership Alliance (FMLA) will sponsor a panel discussion entitled "This Is What a Feminist Looks Like," on Wednesday, March 9, from 7-9 p.m. in the Hansen Student Center (300 Beecher St., Bloomington).
