I have created a hypertext fiction, a work that exists and can only be read in the mutli-dimensional space of the computer. This fiction is a reworking of the story of the fictitious St. Thecla, with connection to my own life—I am named for a series of Tecklas in my family. In this piece, I consciously explore how gender notions shape text, working from a french feminist theoretical perspective. I have been developing a text that unfolds multi-linearly and thus encourages new ways of knowing the text.
