**Background:** Sandra C. Fernandez's most recent work combines her training as a photographer with her sensitive juxtaposition of mixed-media elements. Her works are three-dimensional, initially put into the form of "artist's books," and, more recently, they have become framed sculptures. Fernandez crotchet's, stitches, and sews together different types of fibers, such as handmade paper, tea bags, cigarette wrappings, and reeds, while also including either transfers or collaged parts of her photographs.
