Improve Your Social Life with a Couple of Clicks & a Mouse

BLOOMINGTON, Ill. Bored? Looking for a way to spruce up your social life?

Well, just hop onto the Internet and find Illinois Wesleyan University's homepage, where you can click your way into a new events calendar with more than 200 music, sports, theatre, special speaker, and other events, spanning February to May.

Most of these events are open to the public, free-of-charge. All events are open to IWU students.

Here's how the calendar works:

- Once you're on the Internet, go to IWU's homepage, <<http://www.iwu.edu>>.
- Near the bottom of the homepage, there's a new hot button: What's Happening at IWU! It's labeled, "New." Click on it.
- That will give you another page IWU Information which contains month and year icons. For example, to find out what's going on at IWU this month, click on the "February" "1999" buttons and then the "find" button. A roster of 76 February activities will appear, organized chronologically.
- The roster tells you the name of the event, its location, category (speaker, sports, entertainment, fine arts, etc.), and the month, day, and time of the event.
- For more details about the event, just click on the underlined text.

As new events are scheduled, the calendar will be updated.

Clicking around the new IWU calendar-on-the-web, you'll find out that the Illinois Wesleyan Civic Orchestra is performing on Feb. 19, that the women's basketball team is playing Carthage at the Shirk Center on Feb. 20, and that there's a swing dance on Feb. 27.

Check out IWU's new calendar-on-the-web . . . your social life is guaranteed to improve.

IWU, founded in 1850, enrolls about 2,000 students in a College of Liberal Arts, and individual schools of Music, Theatre Arts, Art, and Nursing. Since 1994, these facilities have been added to the IWU campus: a \$15 million athletics and recreation center, a \$25 million science center, a \$6.8 million residence hall, and a \$5.1 million Center for Liberal Arts.
