Background: Ellis Paul returns to Illinois Wesleyan University to open the spring season of the Blue Moon Coffeehouse series. Known for his passionate yet literate character sketches that deal with the human condition, Paul comes to IWU as part of a national tour for his latest album, "Live." The 2-CD set was recorded live, and includes collaborations with Patty Griffin, Vance Gilbert and Chris Trapper of The Push Stars.

USA Today called Paul a "Best Bet for Stardom," and The Boston Globe recently hailed him as, "a national folk star and to many the quintessential Boston song-writer: literate, provocative, urbanely romantic." Previous records of Paul's have chartered in the Top 5 of the CMJ and Gavin Triple-A radio polls.
