Background: R. Kent Cook joined the Illinois Wesleyan University faculty as an assistant professor of piano in 1999. Cook received a bachelor of music degree in piano performance from Baylor University in 1985, and a master's and doctorate degree in piano performance from Indiana University in 1987 and 1995 respectively. He also studied in Frankfurt, Germany at the Hochschule fur Musik as a Fulbright Scholar in 1993.

He has appeared in many venues around the United States and abroad with performances in Austria, Czech Republic, Germany, England and Italy. He also is a founding member of the Ameropa Piano Trio, which resides at the Ameropa Chamber Music Festival in Prague, Czech Republic during July. Cook also teaches in the summer at Indiana University Piano Academy and the Blue Lake Camp in Blue Lake, Mich.
