Background: O'Malley received a master of arts degree in sculpture from Stanford University in 1999. He is currently on the faculty of the School of Art and a research associate at the Center for Advanced Research Technology in the Arts and Humanities at the University of Washington, Seattle.

O'Malley creates installations and videos that play with architectural space. His recent works, informed by computer games and science fiction, consist of maze-like structures requiring the viewer to travel through passageways or slots, sometimes with only the head exposed, other times only the body.
