Background: Whetherbee is the concertmaster of the Columbus Symphony and performs throughout the country. The Washington Post has called him, "a consummate artist" with "flawless technique." A graduate of the Curtis Institute of Music, Whetherbee made his debut with the National Symphony Orchestra in 1993, and performed in recitals throughout the United States and abroad including Austria, France, Persian Gulf, South Korea, Taiwan and Japan.
