Program: The IWU Civic Orchestra, under the direction of Steven W. Eggleston, IWU professor of music, will features "Overture to Russlan and Ludmilla" by Mikhail Glinka, "Overture to Romeo and Juliet" by Peter Ilych Tchaikovsky and "Symphony No. 8" by Antonin Dvorák.

About Eggleston:

Eggleston earned a bachelor of music education degree from Butler University and a master of music degree in conducting from the University of Michigan where he studied with H. Robert Reynolds. He maintains an active schedule as guest conductor and clinician throughout the United States. He has been a guest conductor for Illinois and Indiana All-State Orchestras and Bands and the University of Illinois String Consortium as well as the Peoria Symphony and Champaign/Urbana Symphony. Eggleston also has served as a guest conductor on the summer music faculty at the University of Michigan, the University of Wisconsin, Butler University and Indiana University.

With the chamber orchestra, Eggleston recorded Mendelssohn's "Italian Symphony" and concert aria, "Infelice," in a compact disc project with IWU's music label Novitas Records. Eggleston's trumpet teachers have included Frank Kaderarbek (Philadelphia Orchestra), Clifford Lillya (University of Michigan) and Delbert Dale (Tokyo and Indianapolis Symphonies). He also is a professor of trumpet at IWU.
