**Background:** Roger Roe is Associate Professor of Oboe and English Horn at Indiana University, and served on the faculty of DePauw University for six years.

He assumed duties as English Horn/Assistant Professor of Oboe for the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra in 1995. In addition to solo appearances with the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra on oboe, oboe d'amore, and English horn, Roe also has performed as a narrator for children's programs.

Before coming to Indianapolis, Roe held oboe and English horn positions with the Honolulu Symphony Orchestra and the Charleston Symphony Orchestra.

Roe is a graduate of the Cleveland Institute of Music, Southern Methodist University, and Arts Magnet High School in Dallas. He is also a past winner of the Fort Worth Young Artist Competition and of a Downbeat Award as Outstanding Young Classical Instrumentalist.
