Influenced by Jacques Brel, Joni Mitchell, Thelonius Monk, Sting, and Nanci Griffith, Werner has released five critically acclaimed CDs including her most recent one "New Non-fiction," which was released in 2001.

An Iowa native with a master's degree in classical voice from Temple University, *New York Times* describes Werner as an "extremely promising singer and songwriter, who writes about changing social patterns from a perspective that is clear-eyed and leavened with humor."
