The IWU Collegiate Choir has established a long history of excellence through its on-campus performances, annual tours and recordings. The choir also sponsors the IWU Choral Commission Series, which in its 50-year history has added many significant works to the choral repertoire and resulted in a number of important world premieres at IWU.

The 51-voice choir is composed of student musicians representing the school of music and other areas of the university and is dedicated to the performance of the finest sacred and secular choral music of the past five centuries. Students in the choir are selected by audition and maintain a rigorous rehearsal schedule in preparation for their concert tour and other engagements throughout the year.

The choir is under the direction of Dr. J. Scott Ferguson, IWU associate professor of music and director of choral activities. Under his direction, choral ensembles have received critical acclaim for their "exquisite discipline, enthusiastic singing and total responsiveness," and for being "one unit of lovely responsive layered sound." Programs have been called "wonderfully well-selected, versatile, interesting and musical."

The program will include selections from the Renaissance to the twenty-first century, featuring sacred compositions by Schütz, Mouton, Gibbons, Brahms and Penderecki, early American sacred music and secular compositions by Sarah Hopkins and Jakko Mäntyjärvi. Of special interest will be the world premiere of "Nocturne" by IWU composer David Vayo, commissioned by the Collegiate Choir for the 2002 Concert Tour.
