The Holy Week Chapel is a worship service centered around Jesus' last meal with his disciples (Luke 22:1-22). Despite being surrounded by enemies in Jerusalem, and with Jesus' own betrayer at the meal, the setting remains one of the great feast/suppers in the Jewish tradition.

It calls to recollection the great affirmation of the Psalmist (Ps.23:5): "Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of my enemies."

As part of the service, Dean of Students James Matthews and Chaplain Groh will serve Holy Communion to anyone who wishes to receive it.
