Admission: The cost for the camp is \$385 for Bloomington-Normal area participants. Housing and meals are available for out of town students.

Concert: A Midwest Cello Celebration is free and open to the public.

Background: The Illinois Wesleyan cello camp is directed by Nina Gordon, cello professor at IWU and the former principal cellist of the Kansas City Symphony.

The camp is open to dedicated cellists of High School and Junior High School ages. The daily schedule includes private cello lessons, cello ensembles, master classes and performances, practice time and elective studies such as: piano, music theory, reading and writing poetry, international dance, painting and drawing, movies and outdoor sports.

Cellists from Illinois, Minnesota, Kansas, Missouri, Wisconsin, Oklahoma and other states also will join the workshops, rehearsals, master classes and performances.
