BLOOMINGTON, Ill. – Recently, 11 Illinois Wesleyan University students were inducted into Alpha Kappa Delta (AKD), the international sociology honor society. The honor is based on students' scholarship and serious interest in sociology, and has more than 490 chapters in the United States, Canada, China, Finland, the Philippines, Taiwan and Singapore. With more than 80,000 members worldwide, 4,000 new members are inducted each year into the organization.

The purpose of AKD "is to study humankind for the purpose of service," said James Sikora, professor of sociology and co-director of the Action Research Center. Established at IWU in 1965, AKD is also open to non-sociology majors as well.
