IWCO to Perform Halloween Pops Concert

BLOOMINGTON, Ill. – The Illinois Wesleyan Civic Orchestra (IWCO) will perform its first concert of the 2010-2011 season on October 29 at 7:30 p.m. at the Bloomington Center for the Performing Arts (110 E. Mulberry St., Bloomington).

Conducted by Professor of Music Steven Eggleston, the 77-member orchestra will open its 26th season with a family Halloween Pops concert narrated by Visiting Assistant Professor of Music Bob Mangialardi. The performance will feature a variety of fright-themed classical favorites including Mussorgsky's "Night on Bald Mountain," Saint Saens' "Danse Macabre" and Dukas' "The Sorcerer's Apprentice," as well as surprises for children in the audience.

General admission is \$10, with a \$5 discount for senior citizens and Illinois Wesleyan alumni, and \$2 for high school and college students with a valid ID. For children 12 and under, admission is free.
