The program will conclude with the Collegiate Choir singing: *Ascendit Deus* by Peter Philips, *Petite Nymfe folâtre* by François Regnard, *Schaffe in mir, Gott, ein rein Herz*, Op. 29, No. 2 by Johannes Brahms, *Libera me* by Lajos Bardos, *Alleluia* by Randall Thompson, *The Stolen Child* by Eric Whitacre and *Ride on, King Jesus* by Edward Boatner.
