Harding and Halperin Named Women of Distinction

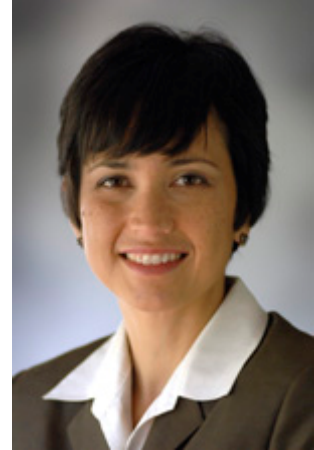
