Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs**

BLOOMINGTON, Ill. – Texas Christian University (TCU) announced today that Kathryn Cavins-Tull, Illinois Wesleyan University vice president for student affairs and dean of students, has been named as its new vice chancellor for student affairs. She will begin her new duties at TCU in Fort Worth, Texas on July 1.

"While I am sorry to be losing Kathy, I cannot help but feel happy for her taking this next step in her career. I am indebted to her for her active engagement in the life of students on this campus, for her efforts to strengthen all offices and programs in student affairs and for her invaluable contributions as a member of my senior leadership team," said IWU President Richard F.
