BLOOMINGTON, Ill.— The Illinois Wesleyan School of Music's Civic Orchestra will give a Halloween concert under the direction of Steven Eggleston, professor of music with narrations by Robert Mangialardi, visiting assistant professor of music. The event will be held Friday, October 25 at 7:30 p.m. in the Bloomington Center for the Performing Arts (600 N. East St., Bloomington).

Admission is free for University students who present an ID, and for students 8th grade and under. High school students will be admitted for \$2.00 with an ID. Kent Cook, professor of music and Ilia Radoslavov, assistant professor of music); *March to the Scaffold* from *Symphonie Fantastique* by Hector Berlioz; and *The Sorcerer's Apprentice* by Paul Dukas.
