BLOOMINGTON, Ill.— A Passover service titled, “From Slavery to Freedom: The Story of Passover” will be held on Wednesday, April 3 at 11 a.m. in the Evelyn Chapel (1301 N. Park St., Bloomington). The service, which is hosted by the Chapel's Multifaith Ambassadors and Illinois Wesleyan Hillel, is open to the public.

Rabbi Lynn Goldstein and Cantor Hilary Bair from Moses Montefiore Congregation in Bloomington will present a musical and academic approach to Passover. They will speak about the traditions of *Tikkun Olam* (repairing the world) and how it relates to current efforts for social justice. Nina Gordon, associate professor of cello and chamber music at Illinois Wesleyan, will also perform.

After the service at 11:45 a.m., there will be a free lunch with Rabbi Goldstein in the Evelyn Chapel basement, hosted by the Chapel and the IWU Interfaith.
