BLOOMINGTON, III. – The State Street Brass Quintet will perform various compositions on Tuesday, Jan. 22 at 8:00 p.m., in Westbrook Auditorium of Presser Hall (1210 N. Park St., Bloomington). The concert is free and open to the public.
