BLOOMINGTON, Ill.— Two Illinois Wesleyan University [music](#) students are eligible to compete at the National Association of Teachers of Singing ([NATS](#)) [2017 national student auditions](#) based on their performances at a recent regional competition.

Crystal Muro '19, a vocal performance major from Itasca, Ill., won second place in the Lower College Women division at the Central Region NATS competition.
