BLOOMINGTON, Ill.— Due to illness, a lecture by the Honorable Gro Brundtland set for Feb. 23 at Illinois Wesleyan University will be rescheduled.

Additional details will be announced when a new date is set. Brundtland, the first female prime minister of Norway and a former director-general of the World Health Organization, was to present the 31st address in the Adlai E. Stevenson Memorial Lecture Series.
