Catie Curtis To Perform at Illinois Wesleyan's Blue Moon Coffeehouse February 15, 2005

BLOOMINGTON, ILL. — Singer/songwriter Catie Curtis, called a "folk-rock goddess" by *The New Yorker*, will appear in concert at Illinois Wesleyan's Blue Moon Coffeehouse on Saturday, Feb. 19.

The show, which is free and open to the public, begins at 8 p.m. in Westbrook Auditorium of Presser Hall (1210 Park St., Bloomington).

A native of rural Maine, Curtis went to Boston as part of the burgeoning indie music scene of the early 1990s. She has released six albums, including her latest, *Dreaming in Romance Languages*, in 2004 on the Vanguard label.

She has toured with Lilith Fair and with such artists as Dar Williams and Mary Chapin Carptner. Her songs have been featured on numerous television shows, including *Chicago Hope* and *Alias*.
