## Illinois Wesleyan to Host Chamber Music Camp and Festival

April 1, 2005

BLOOMINGTON, Ill.-As part of its Summer Music Program, Illinois Wesleyan will host a Chamber Music Camp and Festival for strings, winds, harp and piano June 21-July 2 in Presser Hall (1210 Park St., Bloomington).

The camp is open to high school and junior high school students who wish to participate in intensive chamber music training. The cost of tuition is \$450. Housing and meals for overnight students are available for an additional \$390. Applications can be obtained by visiting the Web site at <https://sun.iwu.edu/~music/k12/camp.html>. The deadline for applying is May 1, 2005. Need-based scholarships are available.

The camp consists of intensive chamber music training that includes daily coaching, rehearsals, master classes, elective studies, and performances by students and faculty.
