Titan Film Series to Include *Pirates* Sequel

BLOOMINGTON, Ill.-The Illinois Wesleyan Office of Student Activities will sponsor the presentation of summer blockbuster *Pirates of the Caribbean: Dead Man's Chest* on Friday, Sept. 22. The film, free and open to the public, will be shown at 8 p.m. and 11 p.m. at the Hansen Student Center, located at 300 Beecher St. in Bloomington.

Dead Man's Chest reunites the cast of 2003's *Pirates of the Caribbean: The Curse of the Black Pearl*, most notably actors Johnny Depp, Orlando Bloom, and Keira Knightley. Gore Verbinski returns as director.

In yet another misadventure, Captain Jack Sparrow (Depp) attempts to escape a blood debt with the supernaturally villainous Davey Jones (Bill Nighy) and avoid the scheming plot of British Royal Navy authorities. Entangled in this plot are a reluctant Will Turner (Bloom) and a defiant Elizabeth Swan (Knightley), who are forced to postpone their wedding in order to secure each other's freedom and go to the aid of Captain Jack.
