## Honor Society for International Scholars to Induct New Members

BLOOMINGTON, Ill. – Illinois Wesleyan University's Epsilon Chi chapter of Phi Beta Delta, an education honor society for international scholars, will hold its third induction ceremony on Tuesday, April 10 at 7 p.m. in the Davidson Room of the Memorial Center (104 University St., Bloomington).

The ceremony and reception to follow is free and open to the public.

Thirty-six students and five faculty members will join the chapter, established in 2005 by Professor of Sociology and Co-Director of International Studies Teodora Amoloza.
