BLOOMINGTON, Ill. — In celebration of its centennial [Homecoming](#), City of Bloomington Mayor Tari Renner proclaimed Oct. 1 as “Illinois Wesleyan University Day.”

Announced at the Sept. 24 Bloomington City Council meeting, Renner said the day will encourage citizens to recognize the importance and impact of the University on the local community.
