## **Eastview High Graduate Wins University Student Senate Award**

BLOOMINGTON, Ill. – Marie Huey of Apple Valley, Minn., a first-year English writing major at Illinois Wesleyan University in Bloomington, Ill., recently won the university's Minor Myers jr. Scholarship. The \$525 award, named after the university's late former president, is presented each spring by IWU's Student Senate.

A 2006 graduate of Eastview High School, Huey was selected from 23 applicants by a committee of student senators based on her resume and answers to three essay questions. The committee sought applications that demonstrated commitment to the university and to the values of a liberal arts education. The scholarship application is open each year any to IWU student with a GPA of at least 3.0 who will continue at the university in the following academic year.

Founded in 1850, Illinois Wesleyan is a private, coeducational university with an enrollment of approximately 2,100 and a student-faculty ratio of 12 to 1. The University consists of the College of Liberal Arts, with 17 academic departments; the College of Fine Arts, comprising professional Schools of Art, Music and Theatre Arts; and the School of Nursing.
