Duo Tandem to Perform Guest Recital

BLOOMINGTON, Ill. – The Illinois Wesleyan University School of Music will present a guest recital, featuring the Duo Tandem. Mark Anderson and Necati Emirzade, guitarists, will perform on Thursday, March 22 at 8 p.m. in Westbrook Auditorium of Presser Hall (1210 N. Park St., Bloomington). The event is free and open to the public.

Duo Tandem was formed while Emirzade and Anderson studied at the San Francisco Conservatory of Music. Brought together by a mutual passion for the music of Astor Piazzolla, the influence of the recordings of the Assad Brothers has expanded their repertoire to include Brazilian music as well. After playing together for the past year, the two are now touring for the first time.

The duo will perform selections from *Suite Retratos* by Radames Gnattali, *Naquele Tempo* and *Lamentos* by Pixinguinha and *Ensimesmado* and *Elegantissima* by Ernesto Nazareth. Following a brief intermission, they will perform *Capriccio Cantabile* by Rex Willis, *Aufenthalt* by Franz Schubert and selections from *Suite Troileana* by Astor Piazzolla.
