BLOOMINGTON, Ill. – The Joyce Eichhorn Ames School of Art will host the annual B.A./B.F.A. Senior Art Exhibitions from April 3 to April 19 in the Merwin and Wakeley Galleries at the Joyce Eichhorn Ames School of Art (6 Ames Plaza, Bloomington).
