BLOOMINGTON, Ill. – On Saturday, April 14, the Illinois Wesleyan School of Music will present a concert by the Symphonic Winds. The event, which is free and open to the public, will take place at 7:30 p.m. in Westbrook Auditorium of Presser Hall (1210 N. Park St., Bloomington).

Conducted by Roger Garrett, assistant professor of music, the ensemble will perform *Old Wine in New Bottles* by Gordon Jacob, *Il Pasticcio Overture* by William P. Latham, *Elegy* by John Barnes Chance, *Dreams of a Psychopath* by Michael Francis, *Emblem of Unity March* J.J. Richards, *Third Suite* by Robert Jager, *Salvation is Created* by Pavel Tschesnokoff and arranged by Bruce H. Housknecht, *Euphoria* by John Frantzen and *Fandango* by Frank Perkins, arranged by Floyd E. Werle.

Comprised of students of all majors, the Symphonic Winds is one of two wind ensembles that perform in concert at Illinois Wesleyan University. The group gives three to four concerts a year, often sharing a concert with the Wind Ensemble and occasionally performing off-campus in the Bloomington-Normal area.
