## Alums to Present Papers in Cuba

BLOOMINGTON, Ill.— Former Illinois Wesleyan University students will present papers at an international conference in Cuba called XIII Simposio Internacional de Comunicacion Social (13<sup>th</sup> International Symposium on Social Communication) Jan. 21 through Jan. 25, 2013.

The conference focuses on communication in multiple ways, such as linguistics, medicine, mass media, art, folklore and computational linguistics. It will be held at the Ministry of Science, Technology and the Environment's location in Santiago de Cuba, the Centre for Applied Linguistics.

Erin Howes, a Hispanic studies major from Glen Ellyn, Ill., who recently graduated in May 2012, will orally present her paper titled "El movimiento Solo Ingles y el futuro linguistico del espanol en los Estados Unidos" (The English Only Movement and the linguistic future of Spanish in the US). Howes wrote this paper from research she completed while taking courses in Hispanic studies and Educational studies.

Colin Schofield, who is also a Hispanic studies major and member of the graduate class of May 2012, from Lake Zurich, Ill., will present his paper "Etnologia del exito academico: los tres lados" (Ethnology of academic success: three sides). Schofield created this paper from his research while studying abroad in Chile.
