## In the Heart of America Featured at McPherson Theatre

BLOOMINGTON, III. – Illinois Wesleyan University's McPherson Theatre will open its 2008-2009 season with playwright Naomi Wallace's *In the Heart of America*. Performances will take place Tuesday, Sept. 30 – Oct. 4 at 8 p.m. and Oct. 5 at 2 p.m. in the McPherson Theatre (2 Ames Plaza East, Bloomington).

In conjunction with the production, there will be a showing of the film *In the Valley of Elah* with a discussion to follow on Saturday, Sept. 27 at 1 p.m. in the Beckman Auditorium located in the basement of The Ames Library (1 Ames Plaza, Bloomington). The film highlights issues surrounding veterans returning from the Iraq War including Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder.

Also complementing the production will be a discussion hosted by a panel of Iraqi War veterans on Wednesday, Oct. 1 from 6-7 p.m. located in Beckman Auditorium.

Directed by associate professor Sandra Lindberg, *In the Heart of America* examines warrelated themes within the context of the Vietnam and Gulf Wars. The play focuses on two soldiers' experiences in the Gulf War featured in flashbacks. The themes of their experiences also manifest in characters who were a part of another conflict, the Vietnam War.

Tickets for *In the Heart of America* will be available beginning Monday, Sept. 22 at the box office of McPherson Theatre. General admission is \$8 for Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Sunday performances and \$10 for Friday and Saturday performances. Student tickets cost \$1 with a valid student ID.
