## Illinois Wesleyan to Host Technology Fair Just in Time for the Holidays

BLOOMINGTON, Ill. – The holiday season is rapidly approaching and it is time to create a perfect wish list. From cell phones to laptops, it is a challenge to keep up with the latest technology. Illinois Wesleyan University's Technology Fair will bring together experts and retailers not only to showcase new items on the market, but also to answer questions and help consumers make decisions to suit their needs.
