IWU Announces Spring 2004 Dean's List

BLOOMINGTON, Ill. – Bryan Noonan of Scottsdale, Ariz., was named to the Dean's List for the spring semester of the 2003-04 academic year at Illinois Wesleyan University.

The Dean's List, which was announced by Acting Provost Roger Schnaitter, includes 857 students from 28 states and 16 countries. To be on the Dean's List, a student must have a grade-point average of 3.50 or better during the semester, based on 4.0 for straight A's.
