Edwardsville Senior H.S. Graduate Elected Student Senate President at Illinois Wesleyan University

BLOOMINGTON, Ill. – Kevin Maliszewski, a junior business administration major from Glen Carbon, Ill., was recently elected president of Illinois Wesleyan University's Student Senate.

Maliszewski is a 2002 graduate of Edwardsville Senior High School.

The Illinois Wesleyan Student Senate is the official representative governing board of the student body. In addition to planning campus activities and programs, the Senate is responsible for representing the student viewpoint in all appropriate phases of University governance and administering student activity fees. As chief administrative official of the Senate, Maliszewski's duties include presiding at all Senate meetings and assuring communication between Senate committees.
