Local Resident to Perform in Concerto/Aria

BLOOMINGTON, Ill. – Suzanne Rovani, a John Hersey High School graduate from Mount Prospect, IL has been selected as one of five winners of Illinois Wesleyan University's annual Henry Charles Memorial Concerto/Aria Competition.

Rovani, a junior majoring in voice, will perform *O, Mio Fernando* by Gaetano Donizetti as a featured voice soloist in the Illinois Wesleyan Civic Orchestra Concerto/Aria Concert. The concert will take place at 7:30 p.m. on Friday, Feb. 22 at the Bloomington Center for the Performing Arts (110 E. Mulberry St., Bloomington).

Tickets for the concert cost \$10 for the general public, with discounts available for senior citizens and IWU alumni.

The competition winners are chosen through a series of auditions conducted during the fall semester. The concert is named in memory of the late Henry Charles, a former faculty member and initiate of Pi Mu Alpha Sinfonia national fraternity. Phi Mu Alpha, whose Alpha Lambda chapter was founded in 1924 at Illinois Wesleyan, has been a contributing sponsor of the Concerto/Aria concert since 1979.
