## Illinois Wesleyan Basketball To Be Televised in Chicago Suburbs

BLOOMINGTON, Ill.—Basketball showdowns between Illinois Wesleyan University and two Windy City-area rivals—Wheaton College and North Central College—will be televised on Chicagoland cable television systems.

The Wheaton game will be televised on Feb. 22 at 8 p.m. on cable channel 29 in Wheaton, Addison, Winfield, Warrenville, Geneva, St. Charles, and West Chicago.

The North Central game will be televised on Feb. 29 at 7 p.m. and on March 1 at 11 a.m. on cable channel 4 in Naperville, Oswego, Aurora, North Aurora, and Montgomery.

The tape-delayed telecasts are of games played on Feb. 19 (Wheaton) and Feb. 22 (North Central) at IWU's Shirk Center.

AT&T Sports says, "The fast-paced action from the Shirk Center will now be available to the fans of Division III basketball in several Chicago suburbs."

IWU, Wheaton, and North Central are members of the College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin.
