**Background:** Howard Bruce Bowlin, rector of St. Matthew's Episcopal Church, Bloomington, will assist University Chaplain Dennis E. Groh in the service.

Prior to coming to Bloomington in 1998, Bowlin served as rector of Christ Episcopal Church in Lockport, N.Y. A music major at the University of Illinois in Urbana-Champaign, Bowlin did graduate work in medieval musicology at the University of Colorado and received his Master of Divinity at the Protestant Episcopal Seminary in Alexandria, Va. He also served in the United States Marine Corps Band for 20 years.

Groh, who graduated from Illinois Wesleyan in 1961 and became Chaplain in 1996, is a specialist in early Christianity and the archaeology of Israel in the Roman and Byzantine periods. He is an ordained elder of the United Methodist Church, and has given addresses at Albion College (Albion, Mich.), Ben-Gurion University of the Negev (Israel), Brown University (Providence, R.I.), National Geographic Society Headquarters (Washington, D.C.), Oxford University (England), Princeton University (Princeton, N.J.), and the University of Chicago.
