Illinois Wesleyan School of Art Announces Juried Student Art Show Winners

BLOOMINGTON, Ill. – Until February 27, the Illinois Wesleyan School of Art is showing works by IWU student artists in the 17th Annual Juried Student Art Exhibition in the Merwin and Wakeley Galleries. Located in the Joyce Eichhorn Ames School of Art, 6 Ames Plaza West, Bloomington, the galleries are open 12-4 p.m., Monday-Friday; 7-9 p.m., Tuesday; and 1-4 p.m., Saturday and Sunday. There is no admission charge; the galleries are open to the public.

Juror John Brunetti, a Chicago curator, art critic, and educator selected the featured works from a large selection of student submissions. The exhibition showcases pieces representing all areas of the university's studio art program, including painting, drawing, printmaking, photography, ceramics, sculpture (including fused glass work), and graphic design.
