Background:	A native of Tennessee, Campbell holds degrees from Northwestern University, where he graduated magna cum laude, and from Indiana University, where he was awarded the Doctor of Music degree in performance with highest distinction. Campbell has performed extensively throughout the United States, Canada, and Great Britain. As a musician he professes marked affinity for the works of Mozart, Schubert, Beethoven, and Liszt.
	A member of the Illinois Wesleyan faculty since 1978, Campbell was named to the School of Music's only endowed chair, the Fern Rosetta Sherff Professor of Music, in 1998. Campbell is currently a professor of music, piano, piano pedagogy, and literature.
